WELCOME TO "WAGGTAILS" THE BEST IN TRAINING YOUR DOG



ARRIVE In plenty of time to settle yourself and dog. If you feel flustered, so will your puppy dog.

FEEDING Try to feed 45 minutes before the class start and only give $\frac{3}{4}$ of the amount of food for tea. **And then bring the rest with you, plus more besides please see my notes on Treat/Rewards below.**

EXERCISE Please **DO NOT** walk your pup or dog for long periods or just before your training class, as this will be of no help when you are training, as this only excites your dog and makes your dog less likely to want to concentrate and settle. My suggestion time for walks is 15 to 20 minutes at any one time while at the puppy stage.

Toilet times and breaks Make sure before coming into the hall your puppy has been able to go to the toilet at home or outside the hall. Remove it and place in the bin at the front of the hall near the tree and phone box. Also take time to allow your puppy to go outside while training as excitement can cause the need to go and puppies cannot hold on.

WHAT TO BRING Nice flat collar and long lead. **Please NO extension leads. Or Choke chains** please. **Harness** if your puppy wears one? Favourite Toy none squeaky, filled Kong a Chew bone to keep them distracted and settled. Extra **Titbits/Rewards see below, but a poo bag, Grooming equipment, Rug or towel for your dog's comfort. Vaccination Certificate please**



TREATS AND REWARDS Small pieces of moist easy to swallow treats. This keeps the dog interested in the reward without filling it up too quickly. Small pieces of cut Edam cheese, as this is low in fat and it doesn't crumble. Hot dog Sausage, liver sausage, chicken roll, luncheon meat and the rest of your dogs own diet, **BUT you need to bring plenty of variety and a good amount in a Tupperware container so you don't run out!**

Please don't bring chocolate drops as these melt and you are likely to get covered!! Also don't bring hard med size biscuits sometimes its

hard to break them, given these to a puppy can fill them up too quickly then the dog loose interest in what you are trying to teach them.

WHAT TO WEAR Flat shoes, comfortable clothes

WHERE TO GO:-

THURSDAY EVENINGS LACH DENNIS VILLAGE HALL CW9 7SZ

Puppies first, 6.30-7.30.pm then **Good Citizen Class 7.45-8.45pm**. From Northwich to Rudheath – Turn left onto B5082 Lach Dennis carry on to end turn right then Lach Dennis village and hall is on your right about 200 yards past the Duke of Portland Pub on the right. **Or from Middlewich** take the turn Kings street, keep following over small bridge to lights, go straight through lights, past the Rudheath sign next you will see the crossroads and Lach Dennis sign turn right follow road till the end, turn right you will see the Duke of Portland pub the hall is just next to this set back off the road.

Or take the turn to Byley pass through Byley to the end opposite you will see the pub “The Three Greyhounds” at junction turn left onto B5082, drive on you will see on the right a garage, continue to Lach Dennis village the hall which is on your left about 200yrds past the garage. This has a large car park please park around the back as that is where we go in.

HELP SHEETS are handed out at times to aid constructive practise at home, being consistent is the “Key” to successful training your puppy.

WHAT WILL I LEARN Teaching owners the skills for kind, fair, Reward based methods. Clicker training can be used if you wish to, in all aspects of dog ownership.

As well as Walking on a loose lead. Basic positions, Sit, Down, Stand, and Coming when called and mixing happily with humans and dogs. The relaxed and friendly atmosphere leads to success and “The Best Certificate” in dog training a well-balanced and controlled pup or dog that’s a pleasure to own. A later class is for those with basic control, ready to tackle more creative training. There is the opportunity to take The Kennel Club Good Citizen Bronze, Silver and Gold Assessments.

THE COURSE Is Six weeks long and each class is approx. one hour long.

WHAT DO I DO IF I MISS A CLASS **Please ring let me know**, and I will give you your missing help sheet for that week.

BITCH IN SEASON **Please, Please leave her at home**, but come yourself. As long as you have learned the handling for that week, you will be able to keep up with her training at home in the back garden.



IF THINGS GO WRONG Between classes PLEASE ring me, don't muddle through you will only be undoing all your hard work you have learned at Waggtails.

BOOKING IN ADVANCED, To secure a Puppy place I need to have a deposit of **£25.00** and then the rest **£25** is paid when you come to **your first lesson**, **Either cash or cheque £50.00 made payable to "Denise Hubbard"**.

If you cancel before starting the course Waggtails will keep the registration fee plus £10.00 to cover administration costs. Any surplus paid will be refunded.

FEES WHEN YOU START AGAIN AFTER your first six weeks of training.
COST £45.00 OR when you start the Activity Class. 7.45pm 8.45pm

HOWEVER,

If you would like to have "One To One" Behavioural consultation then a training modification program will start. This can be arranged also this enables you and your dog to become more relaxed, confident and understanding of just what is needed in the training class. It especially helps with dogs that are nervous of other dogs or people, but still need the training experience to combat problem areas.

COST £50.00 an hour.

OR

TRAINING HELP AND ADVICE "One to One" AT HOME

COST From £30.00 depending on the length of time needed.

DOG WALKING For the owners who are pushed for time, or just not able to get back at lunch times, let me take that pressure off by walking your pet, giving it some mental stimulation and playful interaction with other dogs.
£10.00 Visit, Feed and Let Out £12.00 Visit, Feed, Lead walk £15.00 Visit, Feed and One Hour Walk or Free Run either on extension lead or not.

AT THE END of the Six weeks presentation of The Kennel Club Good Citizen Puppy Awards. This is only achieved if you have come for FIVE out of the SIX weeks, as if you miss more than this you will fall behind and it's difficult to catch up. As each week is structured in a way to help your training flow along, as training will then go into A, B, then C and so on. Activity Class is taught and trained ready for The Kennel Club Good Citizen Bronze, Silver or Gold assessments.

BEST OF ALL Waggtails School Of Dog Training is Fun and to be enjoyed, by both Owners, pup or dog so please be patient, come and learn so you can achieve the control you need for the future well behaved, mannered adult dog.
